


University of Iowa
Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
Issued June 15, 2026

Status: Closed

Biochemistry and Molecular Biology is a department within the Carver College of Medicine that administers both undergraduate and graduate degree programs and conducts research. The audit was performed to evaluate operational processes and financial management controls. Observations and testing of the department’s physical security, computer inventory, and grant and gift fund management were performed. No material audit findings or weaknesses were noted during this audit. This audit is closed.



University of Iowa
UI Health Care Admission and Transfer Center
Issued June 15, 2026

Status: Open

The Admission and Transfer Center is a centralized, operational resource responsible for coordinating the admission and transfer of patients into and across the University of Iowa Health Care enterprise. The audit was performed to evaluate if proper controls are in place and determine whether opportunities for improvement exist. Audit recommendations include implementing standardized intake-process workflows, optimizing triage guidance materials, implementing routine reporting and monitoring practices, developing key performance indicators, and optimizing the identification of over-and-back patient transfers. Management expects to complete its action plans by December 2026.



**Iowa State University
Center for Survey Statistics and Methodology**

Status: Open

The Center for Survey Statistics and Methodology specializes in the research and practice of sample surveys. Primary audit recommendations involve formalizing processes related to access management, employee onboarding and offboarding, data standards and strategic planning. Management expects to complete its action plans by January 2027.

The North Central Regional Aquaculture Center (NCRAC) at Iowa State University is one of the five Regional Aquaculture Centers established by Congress that are administered by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA). The mission of the Regional Aquaculture Centers is to support aquaculture research, development, demonstration, and extension education to enhance viable and profitable U.S. aquaculture to benefit consumers, producers, service industries, and the American economy. Audit recommendations involve formalizing processes related to research oversight meetings, budget documentation, and center policy. Management expects to complete its action plans by April 2027.

Status: Open




The Thielen Student Health Center (TSHC) reports to the Division of Student Affairs and is a nationally accredited and licensed on-campus medical clinic for students. This audit was conducted to evaluate administrative processes and provide reasonable assurance that internal controls are in place and operating as intended. Recommendations include strengthening billing management oversight practices, establishing training requirements, following record retention guidelines, reducing physical access to controlled spaces, and regularly reviewing system access. Management expects to complete its action plans by September 2026.
